The Trip Itinerary and Courses



Metropolitan Tabernacle

We feature guest English instructors lecturing on British History and British Fine Arts. Students will receive 8 hours college credit. The course will include an integrated study of Art, Music, and theology and British History. On Sundays we will attend Spurgeon’s Metropolitan Tabernacle and stay and dine with London families.

Chambers College credit is obtained by taking two three-hour courses. The other two hours credit are gained on the trip by keeping a diary and/or writing a paper. You may travel to London without attending the courses (unfortunately there is no reduction in price for not taking the courses.)



Past itineraries have included two concerts by London symphonic orchestras, Agatha Christie’s play *The Mousetrap*, Tower of London, Wesley’s Chapel, Bunhill Cemetery, National Gallery Art Museum, British Museum, a day trip to Cambridge and

a day of sightseeing, Baroque concert at St. Martin’s-in-the-Field, river cruise on the Thames, tour bus ride of London, and other sites and events as time permits. We spend a few hours in the Evangelical Library with the leather bound books doing final research on course papers.

Price and payment deadlines

The total price will be \$2,900 if registered by September 1, (\$3,000 after Sept 1). This price includes round trip airfare from Denver, all travel in London, room, all meals, event tickets, trip to Cambridge. The non-refundable deposit of \$1,000 is used to book the flights and make other deposits. Final full payment is due October 1. We can only refund to the degree we do not experience administrative costs and cancellation fees.
